Dear Search Committee,

For the past 15 years, I have been working as a curator and producer of artist centered programming in the field of visual arts and live performance. My artistic research spans various disciplines, including art history, photography, video, architecture, performance, pop culture, and advertising with a particular focus on early avant-garde movements, queer studies, and interplay between art making and psychoanalysis.

As a curator of four Performa Biennials, I organized and produced dozens of performances and original programs that challenged artists to imagine live performances out of their visual art practices. I commissioned both institutional and emerging artists to develop their very first live performances while also supporting the development of more experienced time-based artists. For example, I organized Barbara Kruger's first live work that unfolded through a skate park and 'drop' performance that merged branding and live art, Korakrit Arunanondchai and boychild's breakthrough into choreography, as well as Kia LaBeija's Bauhaus ballet for the voguing community. I also organized video programs that bridged archival performances with contemporary social communities. For example, *Time Share* reimagined performances by Judy Chicago, Robert Rauschenberg, and Shigeko Kubota through social media and queer resistance. Additionally, *Excelsior*, which was named after Captain Sulu's Star Trek spaceship, explored themes of dystopia and self-mythology by video directors from the Asian diaspora.

My communication skills have been successful in drawing in new audiences, cultivating board members, identifying funding resources, and amplifying media attention. One recent accomplishment was initiating the redesign of Performa's organizational <u>website</u>, which is often cited as the new museum industry standard. The site makes art and performance more accessible through streaming video and live broadcasts on a fluid interface.

My nontraditional career path into curating is due to my background as a studio artist. I've developed an acute intuitive instinct that comes from my formative years sharing studio spaces with fellow artists and designers. I've had several solo exhibitions as an artist and participated in group shows at arts organizations on both coasts. My ongoing attendance and dialogue with key international art biennials and festivals continue to challenge new forms of exhibition making in relation to radical urbanism.

I remain curious through regularly attending international exhibitions, conferences, and artist studios to ensure that curatorial projects address the most pressing and relevant issues of our time. Through effective storytelling and creative problem solving, art continues to be a genre defying field that forges dynamic connections between the imagination and the future.

I am thrilled at the prospect of bringing my experience and knowledge to Los Angeles Nomadic Division, and I look forward to the opportunity to discuss my qualifications further.
